

Welcome to the Black and Asian Leadership Initiative

The programme for 2018 includes:

- An initial 2 day residential (September 2018), introducing the concept of cultural competence
- support in producing and maintaining reflection on your learning journey
- A follow up one-day workshop (November 2018) on how to step up to a strategic role
- Mentoring support for participants who identify this as a preference

The programme is aimed at experienced middle leaders, working in children's services, who identify themselves as being from a black or minority ethnic background, and have the support of the organisation that employs them. An email will be sent to your line manager or other relevant senior officer, when you enter their contact details as part of this process, asking whether your application is supported.

Places are limited and should the programme be oversubscribed, priority will be given to applicants who are able to make the most compelling case for being offered a place. This will be judged by reference to the following criteria:

- Your commitment to a career in children's services,
- Your potential to become a senior leader in children's services,
- The match between this programme and your own development needs.

The application round will be open from 14th May and closes on 15th June 2018. This is also the deadline for supporting statements from line managers. Late applications cannot be accepted.

Once your application has been submitted and the round is closed, you will be contacted to confirm the outcome.

The cost of the programme is £595 + VAT and will be invoiced prior to the start of the programme.
